

**CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. 12-13-166 APPROVING
PURCHASE OF CSCOPE THROUGH EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER 10**

The Administration recommends approval of Resolution No. 12-13-166 Approving Purchase of CSCOPE through Education Service Center 10.

NOTES:

The department of Teaching and Learning respectfully requests the renewal of the CSCOPE Curriculum Management System and Content from ESC Region 10.

CSCOPE is utilized as the curriculum management system in Irving ISD. The Texas Education Service Center Curriculum Collaborative (TESCCC) continues to revise CSCOPE to align with state changes in Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills, and with the state accountability system. Irving ISD also continues to embed district resources, lessons and materials to ensure a quality curriculum for teachers.

The total cost for the C-Scope Curriculum Management System and Content is \$189,505. Eduphoria is bundled into the contract for \$67,650. There is a \$5,000 discount for bundling. The total cost is \$252,155. The funds will be allocated from the 2013-2014 general operating budget.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, IRVING
INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, APPROVING A
DISTRICT USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR CSCOPE
CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND PROVIDING FOR
OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT
MATTER**

WHEREAS, the District and the Department of Teaching and Learning is in need curriculum revisions and a management system to improve teaching and learning designed to support the Texas Assessment Program through STAAR Assessment and End-of-Course Examinations; and

WHEREAS, Regional Education Service Centers ("ESC") are authorized by Chapter 8 Tex Educ Code to assist school districts in improving student performance, to operate more efficiently and economically, to provide services to school districts, to maintain core services for purchase by school districts, to offer any service requested and purchased by any school district, and to contract with any public or private entity for services; and

WHEREAS, Section 11.157 Tex Educ Code authorizes the Board of Trustees to contract with a public or private entity to provide educational services for the district; and

WHEREAS, Texas Education Service Center Curriculum Collaborate ("TESCCC") is a non-profit corporation authorized to do business by the Texas Secretary of State created and organized by Directors of fourteen (14) ESC's; and

WHEREAS, TESCCC pursuant to Chapter 8 Tex Educ Code has developed or caused to be developed a curriculum management system known as CSCOPE, the focus of which is to impact instructional practices in the classroom to improve student performance; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Teaching and Learning has proposed a District User License Agreement from and with TESCCC for a license to use the CSCOPE Curriculum Management System and content; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Teaching and Learning and the Director of Purchasing has found that the services to be provided by TESCCC constitute professional services as contemplated by Section 44.031(f) Tex Educ Code; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing has certified that the procurement of the CSCOPE System is in compliance with Board Policy CH (LOCAL) and Section 44.031(a) and (b) Tex Educ Code; and

WHEREAS, the Associate Superintendent for Business Services has represented that sufficient Maintenance and Operating Funds have been budgeted and appropriated to defray the costs of the District User License Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Assistant Superintendent for Teaching and Learning and the Superintendent of Schools have recommended approval of the District User License Agreement with TESCCC; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, based on the foregoing representations, certifications and recommendations desires to obtain the District User License from TESCCC and to approve the TESCCC Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE IRVING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1: The above and foregoing recitals be, and are hereby, found to be true and correct and are incorporated into the body of this Resolution verbatim.

Section 2: The District User License Agreement with TESCCC be, and is hereby, approved substantially in the form of Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference as if copied herein verbatim, subject to availability of budgeted and appropriated funds.

Section 3: The President of the Board of Trustees be, and is hereby, authorized to execute the TESCCC License Agreement as hereby approved.

Section 4: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was considered was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given and posted, all as required by Chapter 551, Tex Gov't Code, as amended.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect upon its enactment and the License Agreement, as approved, shall be effective July 1, 2013.
